



NOTES TO THE ACCOUNTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 MARCH 2009

1 Accounting policies

1.1 Basis of preparation

The accounts have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

The accounts have been prepared in accordance with applicable accounting standards, the Statement of Recommended Practice, "Accounting and Reporting by Charities", issued in March 2005 and the Charities Act 1993.

1.2 Incoming resources

Membership income is accounted for on a receivable basis.

Donations and gifts are credited to the statement of financial activities in the year in which they are receivable.

1.3 Resources expended

The costs of generating funds are all expenditure incurred on raising funds to finance charitable activities.

Charitable expenditure comprises all the expenditure incurred by the Association in meeting the charitable objects, including cost of management, administration and compliance with constitutional and statutory requirements.

1.4 Tangible fixed assets and depreciation

Tangible fixed assets other than freehold land are stated at cost less depreciation. Depreciation is provided at rates calculated to write off the cost less estimated residual value of each asset over its expected useful life, as follows:

Freehold land is not depreciated

Freehold buildings 2% straight line
Sport equipment 20% reducing balance
Utensils 20% reducing balance
Furniture and fittings 20% reducing balance
P A System 20% reducing balance

1.5 Accumulated funds

Restricted funds represent monies raised to acquire the freehold property in which the charity furthers its aims and objectives.

Designated funds comprise funds which have been set aside at the discretion of the trustees for specific purposes. The purpose and use of the designated funds are solely for the future purchase of freehold buildings.

1.6 Value added tax

Value added tax is not recoverable by the charity and such is included in the relevant costs in the statement of financial activities.
